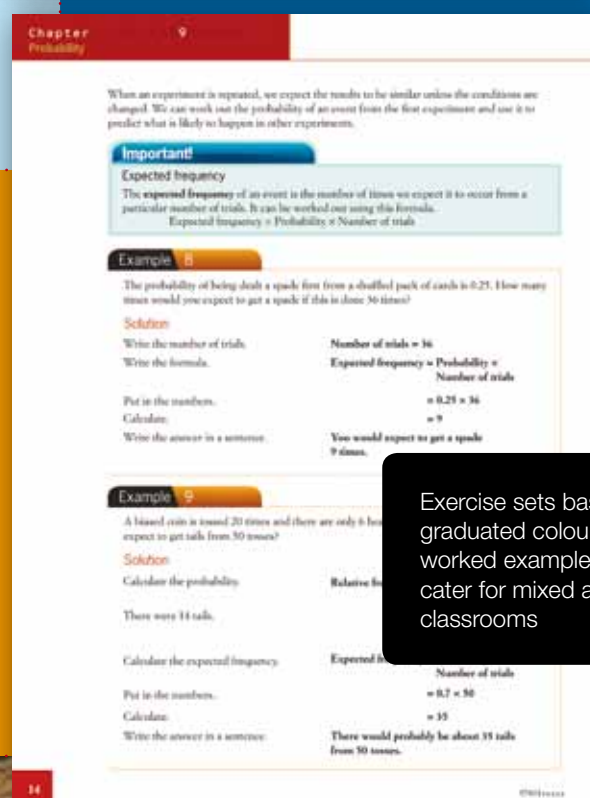
Teacher Resources
